Another great use of **Freecycling** is to **ask to borrow something for a bit**, i.e. tools, medical equipment, travel equipment, etc...

It is free to sign up, all offers and acceptances are done via email. If you accept something, you just arrange to pick it up. Since this group is all St Matts folks you can even swap stuff at church.

What is Freecycling?

The Freecycle Network™ is made up of 4,934 groups with 8,338,153 members around the world. It's a grassroots and entirely nonprofit movement of people who are giving (and getting) stuff for free in their own towns. It's all about reuse and keeping good stuff out of landfills. Each local group is moderated by local volunteers (them's good people).

Membership is free.
